



Willow Fork Drainage District's Central Green Fact Sheet

- Central Green is a multipurpose public park and events venue owned and operated by the Willow Fork Drainage District. The community space is located on the south end of LaCenterra at Cinco Ranch in Katy, Texas.
- The halfg acre community park is funded by a voterg approved parks bond package for the Willow Fork Drainage District.
- Central Green was created to fulfill a public need where Katy residents could gather for local community events such as concerts, movies and community classes.
- Central Green is part of a master plan of interconnecting parks, trails and outdoor recreational spaces designed to create a sense of unity between existing neighborhoods and local schools to regional destinations such as George Bush Park and Terry Hershey Park.
- Central Green features outdoor seating areas, a central mall ringed by stone benches and trees as well as a performance stage and restroom facility.
- Designed by landscape architecture firm TBG, construction of Central Green was completed in May 2013 and officially opened to the public on June 1, 2013.
