(April 21, 2016) -- Willow Fork Drainage District has received updated information today from the Fort Bend County Office of Emergency Management on the projected water levels in the Barker Cypress Reservoir. At this time, the Barker Cypress Reservoir is expected to crest next Tuesday, April 26, 2016, at a level of 96.3 feet. With this projected crest, the areas immediately adjacent to the Barker Cypress Reservoir could experience street flooding in amounts not to exceed six to twelve inches. The FBOEM will continue to update its model, and this projection is subject to change.
